At Volta Museum we would like to celebrate the unsung women and men on special anniversaries of their choice.

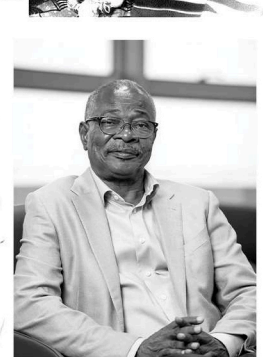
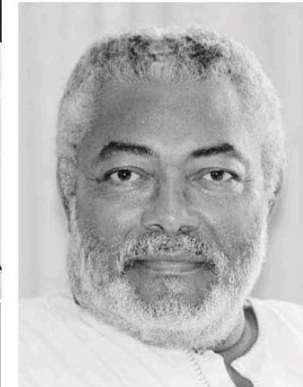
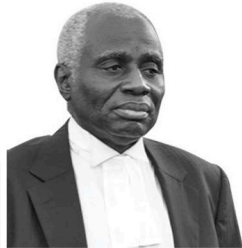
The achievements of sons and daughters from Voltaland of Ghana will be brought forward and presented to young adults at this special event.

## VOLTA BUSINESS INCUBATOR

The Volta Business Incubator (VBI) is one of the advance forms of promoting entrepreneurial spirit of Voltaian in Ghana been used by SAFE Ghana.

SAFE Ghana seeks to build stronger partnerships to promote increased understanding of Voltaian entrepreneurship to reduce unemployment, reduce urban rural migration, productivity, generate revenue and expand the local, regional and sub-regional economies.

Discussions and roundtables at the Volta Museum premises will analyze opportunities and bottlenecks in business. Pragmatic business solutions shall be provided by young business men and women from Voltaland.

At the core of the VBI program is a training curriculum that's offers coaching, mentoring, tutorials, field trips, business trips, interface meetings, team building, resource mobilization, and grooming for business programmes.

In addition a Volta Investment Fund is to provide working/ startup capital up to a threshold to the young entrepreneurs.

SAFE Ghana is therefore seeking partnership with public and private sector actors to open discussions and demonstrate how to build stronger entrepreneurs, discover new businesses and accelerate businesses to spur sustained economic growth in Voltaland.
